

## **Revelation 10 Outline**

### **1A** The strong angel, vv.1-6:

**1B** The descent and physical appearance of the strong angel, 1: And I saw a strong angel descending from heaven, surrounded by a cloud, and the rainbow upon his head, and his face like the sun, and his feet like pillars of fire,

**2B** The possession of the strong angel, 2a: and having an opened book in his hand;

**3B** The position of his feet, 2b: and his feet stood at the right hand of the sea, and his left foot on the land,

**4B** The summons with a loud voice, 3: And he cried out with a loud voice like a lion bellows; and when he cried out, the seven thunders spoke their voices.

**5B** The prohibition of the revelation of the seven thunders, 4: And when the seven thunders spoke, I was about to write; and I heard a voice from heaven, saying, "Seal what the seven thunders speak, and do not write them."

### **6B** The oath of the strong angel, vv.5-6:

**1C** The preparation for the oath, 5: And the angel whom I saw standing upon the sea and upon the land raised up his right hand to heaven,

**2C** The oath of the angel, 6a: and swore by the one who lives forever and ever, who created heaven and those in it, and the earth and those in it, and the sea and those in it,

**3C** The oath, 6b: that there should no longer be a delay;

**2A** The completion of the promised mystery, 7: but in the days of the sound of the seventh angel, whenever he is about to blow, then the mystery of God will be completed, as He declared to His servants the prophets.

### **3A** The little book, vv.8-10:

**1B** The command to get the little book, 8: And the voice which I heard from heaven, speaking with me again, and saying, "Go, take the opened little book in the hand of the angel who stands on the sea and on the earth."

**2B** The command of the angel regarding the little book, 9: And I went back to the angel, telling him to give me the little book. And he says to me, "Take and devour it. And it will make your stomach bitter, but in your mouth it will be sweet like honey."

**3B** The execution of the command and result, 10: And I took the book from the hand of the angel, and I devoured it, and it was in my mouth like honey, sweet; and when I swallowed it, my stomach was made bitter.

**4A** A new command, 11: And they said to me, "It is necessary for you to prophesy again about many peoples and nations and tongues and kings."
