

Revelation 13 Outline

1A The beast from the sea, vv.1-10:

- 1B** The appearance of the blasphemous beast from the sea, 1: Then I stood on the sand of the sea; and I saw a beast rising from the sea, having ten horns and seven heads, and upon his horns ten diadems, and upon his head, a name of blasphemy.
- 2B** Physical description, 2: And the beast, which I saw, was like a leopard, and his feet were like a bear, and his mouth was like the mouth of a lion; and the dragon gave to him his power, and his throne, and great authority.
- 3B** The wounding of the beast, 3: And I saw one of his heads, as if being wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed; and the whole earth marveled after the beast;
- 4B** The worship of the dragon and the beast, 4: And they worshipped the dragon who gave authority to the beast, and they worshipped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast? And who is able to war with him?"
- 5B** The nature and span of his authority 5: And he was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies and authority was given to him to make war forty two months.
- 6B** The blasphemy of the beast, 6: And he opened his mouth in blasphemy toward God, to blaspheme His name, and his tabernacle, those who camp in heaven.
- 7B** The conquests of the beast, 7: And it was given to him to make war with the saints, and to conquer them; and authority was given to him over every tribe and people and tongue and nation.
- 8B** Universal worship of the beast, 8: And all who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the book of the life of the Lamb, the One slain from the foundation of the world.
- 9B** Call to listen, 9: If anyone has an ear, let him hear.
- 10B** Universal power of the beast, 10a: If anyone is held captive, he goes; if anyone kills with the sword, it is necessary for him to be killed with a sword.
- 11B** Declaration regarding the saints, 10b: Here is the endurance and faith of the saints.

2A The second beast, vv.11-18:

- 1B** The source and physical description of the beast, 11: And I saw another beast rising from the earth, and he was having two horns like a lamb and speaking like a dragon.
- 2B** Relationship to the first beast, 12: And he wields all the authority of the first beast before him. And he makes the earth and those who dwell in it that they might worship the first beast, whose wound of death was healed.
- 3B** The signs of the second beast, 13: And he makes great signs, even fire that descends from heaven upon the earth before men.
- 4B** The deception of the second beast, 14: And he deceives those who dwell upon the earth through the signs who were given by him to make before the beast, saying to the

dwellers upon the earth to make an image to the beast who has the wound from the sword and he lives.

5B The blasphemous life from the beast to the image, 15: And it was given to him to give breath to the image of the beast, that also the image of the beast might speak.

6B The mark of the beast, vv.16-17:

1C The forcing of the mark on all, 16: And he makes all, the small and the great, and the rich and the poor, and the free and the slave to give to them an impression on their right hand, or on their foreheads,

2C The power of the mark, 17: and that no one might be able to buy or sell, unless that one has the impression, the name of the beast or the number of his name.

7B The number of the beast, 18: Here is wisdom. The one who has a mind tabulate the number of the beast; for it is the number of a man, and his number is six hundred sixty six.
