

Revelation 14 Outline

1A The new song to the Lamb, vv.1-5:

- 1B** The Lamb and His witnesses, 1: And I saw, and look, the Lamb standing upon Mount Zion, and with him the number one hundred forty four thousand having His name and the name of His Father written upon their foreheads.
- 2B** The powerful, wonderful voice, 2 And I heard a voice from heaven, like the voice of many waters, and like the voice of great thunder; and the voice which I heard was like harpists harping on their harps.
- 3B** The new song and its audience, 3: And they sang a new song before the throne, and before the four living things, and the elders, and no one is able to learn the song, except the one hundred and forty four thousand, who were purchased from the earth.
- 4B** The holy and humble and precious nature of the singers, 4: These are those who were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are those who follow the Lamb wherever He leads. These were purchased by Jesus from among men, firstfruits to God and to the lamb.
- 5B** Their blameless and deceitless nature, 5: And in their mouth was found no deceit for they are blameless.

2A A procession of angels, vv.6-12:

1B The first angel, vv.6-7:

- 1C** The first angel, the nature of his message and his audience, 6: And I saw an angel flying in mid-heaven, having the everlasting Gospel, to proclaim to those sitting upon the earth, and to every nation, and tribe, and tongue and people,
- 2C** The message of the first angel, 7: saying in a loud voice, "Fear the Lord, and give to Him glory, because the hour of judgment is come, and worship Him who made heaven and the earth and the sea and the springs of water.

2B The second angel, and his announcement, 8: And another second angel followed, saying, "Babylon the Great has fallen, because she has made all the nations drink from the wine of the wrath of her fornication."

3B The third angel and his warning, vv.9-12:

- 1C** The condition of his warning, 9: And another third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, "If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives the mark upon his forehead, or upon his hand,
- 2C** The result of the condition is fulfilled, 10: then he himself will drink from the wine of the wrath of God, which is mixed undiluted in the cup of His wrath, and he will be tortured by fire and brimstone before the holy angels, and before the Lamb.

- 3C The lasting nature of their torment, 11: And the smoke of their torment will ascend forever and ever; and they will not have rest day and night, those who worship the beast and his image, and if anyone receive the mark of his name.
- 4C The contrasting endurance of those who reject the mark, 12: Here is the endurance of the holy ones; those who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus.
- 3A Interlude, the rest of the dead, 13: Then I heard a voice from heaven saying, "Write, "Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on." "Yes," says the Spirit, "that they will rest from their labors; and their works follow after them."
- 4A The angels, the Son of Man, and the harvest, vv.14-20:
- 1B The Son of Man and His sickle, 14: And I saw, and look, a white cloud, and upon the cloud sitting one like the Son of Man, having upon his head a gold crown, and in His hand a keen sickle.
- 2B The command of the first angel, 15: And another angel exited from the temple, crying out in a great voice to the one sitting upon the cloud, "Send your sickle and reap, because the hour to reap is come, because the harvest of the earth is ripe."
- 3B The harvest of the Son of Man, 16: And the one sitting upon the cloud cast His sickle upon the earth, and He reaped the earth.
- 4B A second angel and his sickle, 17: And another angel exited the temple which is in heaven, having also the same sharp sickle.
- 5B The third angel and his command, 18: And another angel exited from the altar, having authority over fire and he voiced a loud cry to those have the sharp sickle, saying, "Send your keen sickle and gather the bunches from the vine of the earth, because her grapes are ripe."
- 6B The harvest of the angel, 19: And the angel cast his sickle to the earth, and gather the vine of the earth, and he cast to the great winepress of the wrath of God.
- 7B The product of the winepress, 20: And the winepress was trampled outside the city, and blood issued from the winepress as high as the bridles of horses for one thousand six hundred stadia.
