

Revelation 15 Outline

- 1A** The coming of another sign, and its significance, 1: Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous, seven angels holding the seven last plagues, because in them the wrath of God was completed.
- 2A** The song of the victorious, vv.2-4:
 - 1B** The identity of the singers, 2: And I saw like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have victory from the beast and from his image, and from the number of his name, standing upon the sea of glass, having harps of God.
 - 2B** The source of the song, 3a: And they sing the song of Moses the slave of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying,
 - 3B** The words of the song, 3b-4: "Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, King of the Nations! 4 Who does not fear You, Lord, and glorify Your name? Because You alone are holy; because the nations will come and worship Your face; because your judgments have been manifested!
- 3A** The opening of the temple of witnesses, 5: And after these things I saw, and the temple of the tabernacle of the witnesses in heaven opened.
- 4A** The exit of the seven angels, 6a: And the seven angels came out from the temple, who have the seven plagues,
- 5A** The physical description of the angels, 6b: who were clothed in pure bright linen, and having their chests girded with golden bands.
- 6A** The giving of the bowls, 7: And one of the four living things gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls, laden of the wrath of God who lives forever and ever.
- 7A** The filling of the temple, and its temporary emptiness, 8: And the temple was laden with the smoke of the glory of God, and of His power, and no one is able to enter into the temple, until the seven plagues of the seven angels is concluded.
