

Revelation 19 Outline

1A The first worship of the great multitude, vv.1-4:

1B The first declaration of the greatness and goodness of God, vv.1-2:

1C Declaration, 1: After these things I heard a great voice of a huge multitude in heaven, saying, "Halleluia; the salvation and the power and the glory of our God;

2C Reasons, 2:

1D First reason, character of His judgments, 2a: because true and righteous are His judgments;

2D Second reason, application of His judgments toward the great prostitute and her victims, 2b: because He judged the great prostitute, who corrupted the earth with her fornication, and He has avenged the blood of His servants from her hand."

2B Second declaration 3: And a second time they said, "Halleluia. And her smoke ascends forever and ever."

3B The response of the elders and living things, 4: And the twenty four elders fell, and the four living things, and they worshipped God sitting on the throne, saying, "Amen, Halleluia."

2A The second worship of the great multitude, vv.5-9:

1B A call to worship, 5: And a voice came out from the throne, saying, "Praise our God, all His servants, and those who fear Him, the small and the great."

2B The response to call, vv.6-8:

1C The character of the response, 6a: And after hearing the voice of a huge crowd, even like the sound of many waters, and like the sound of strong thunder, saying,

2C Praise for the reign of God, 6b: "Halleluia; because our Lord God Almighty reigns.

3C Exhortation to rejoice, 7a: Let us rejoice and let us exult, and let us give glory to Him;

4C Reasons for rejoicing, 7b-8:

1D Arrival of the wedding, 7b: because the wedding of the Lamb has come, and His wife prepared herself.

2D Beauty of the bride, 8a: And it was given to her that she be decked out in linen, radiant and pure;

3D Explanation of the beauty, 8b: For the linen is the righteousnesses of the saints.

5C The blessing for those in attendance, 9: And He says to me, "Write, "Blessed are those summoned to the marriage supper of the Lamb." And He says to me, "These sayings are the true ones of God."

3A John's personal response to the angel, 10:

1B Attempt to worship, 10a: And I fell before His feet to worship Him;

2B The admonition of the angel, 10b: and He says to me, “Do not look! I am your fellow-servant and of your brothers who have the testimony of Jesus; Worship God; For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

4A The One on the white horse, vv.11-16:

1B His place, His mount, His character, 11: And I saw heaven opened, and look, a white horse, and the one sitting on it, called faithful and true, and He judges and makes war in righteousness.

2B His eyes and His crowns, 12: And His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns; having names written and one name written except Himself,

3B His robe and His name, 13: and being clothed with a robe dipped in blood; and His name is called, the Word of God.

4B His armies and their mounts and raiment, 14: And the armies which are in heaven followed Him upon white horses, being clothed in pure white linen.

5B His sword and His wrath toward the Gentiles, 15: And from His mouth issues a sharp two-edged sword, that with it He might strike the Gentiles; and He Himself will shepherd them with an iron rod; and He Himself treads the winepress of the wine of the burning of the wrath of God Almighty.

6B His robe and His name, 16: And He has upon His robe and upon His thigh a name written, King of kings and Lord of lords.

5A The defeat of the beast, vv.17-21:

1B The summons to the birds, vv.17-18:

1C The summons, 17: And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a great voice, saying to all the birds that fly in mid-heaven, “Come, gather to the great supper of God,

2C The meal, 18: That you might eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of chiliarchs, and the flesh of strong men, and the flesh of horses and those sitting upon them, and the flesh of all, free and slave, and small and great.

2B The muster of the beast and his minions, 19: And I saw the beast and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war with the One sitting on the horse, and with His army.

3B The capture and judgment of the beast and the false prophet, 20: And the beast was captured, and with the false prophet who made the signs in his presence, by which those who received the mark of the beast were deceived, and those who worshipped his image; the two were cast living into the lake of fire which burns with brimstone.

4B The end of the rest, 21: And the rest were killed with the sword of the One sitting on the horse, which was coming out from His mouth; and all the birds were gorged from their flesh.
