

## **Revelation 21 Outline**

### **1A All things new, vv.1-5a:**

- 1B** The new heaven and new earth, 1: Then I saw a new heaven and new earth; For the first heaven and the first earth departed, and the sea did not exist anymore.
- 2B** The new Jerusalem, 2: And the holy city, New Jerusalem, I saw descending from heaven, from God, prepared like a bride adorned for her husband.
- 3B** The new tabernacle, 3: And I heard a great voice from heaven, saying, "Look, the tabernacle of God with men, and He will tabernacle with them, and they will be his people, and He will be their God.
- 4B** The end of sorrow, 4: And God will wipe away all tears from their eyes, and death will not exist anymore; because the first things have departed."
- 5B** The announcement, 5a: And the One sitting on the throne said, "Look, I make all things new."

### **2A Distinctions in heaven, vv.5b-8:**

- 1B** Command to write, 5b: And He says to me, "Write. Because these words are true and faithful."
- 2B** Self-identification, 6a: And He said to me, "I come. The Alpha and the O, the beginning and the end.
- 3B** The great privilege, 6b: I Myself will give to drink freely from the fountain of the water of life.
- 4B** The privileged and their future, 7: The one who conquers will inherit these things, and I will be God to him, and he will be a son to Me.
- 5B** The destruction of the inheritance of the faithless, 8: But to the cowardly and faithless and sinful and abominable and murderers, immoral and poisoners and idolaters, and to all liars, their part will be in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.

### **3A The New Jerusalem, vv.9-27:**

- 1B** Summons from one of the bowl-angels, 9: And one of the seven angels came, of those holding the seven bowls laden with the seven last plagues, and he spoke with me, saying, "Come, I will show you the wife, the bride of the Lamb."
- 2B** The tour of the New Jerusalem, 10: And he carried me away in spirit on the great and high mountain, and he showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending from the heaven, from God,
- 3B** The glory of the city, 11: having the glory of God; her light was like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, glittering;

- 4B** The wall, the gates, and their names, 12: having a great and high wall, having twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the sons of Israel.
- 5B** The distribution of the gates, 13: From the east, three gates; and from the north three gates, and from the south, three gates, and from the west three gates.
- 6B** The foundations of the wall and their names, 14: And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and upon them twelve names of the twelve apostles of the lamb.
- 7B** The measure of the dimension, vv.15-17:
- 1C** The measuring tool, 15: And the one who speaks with me had a gold measure-reed, that he might measure the city, and its gates, and its wall.
  - 2C** The shape of the city, and its dimensions, 16: And the city is set four-corners, and its length is the same as its breadth. And he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand stadia; twelve width and breadth and height are equal.
  - 3C** The dimensions of the wall, 17: And he measured its walls each one hundred forty four cubits, a measure of a man, which is of an angel.
- 8B** The materials of construction, vv.18-21:
- 1C** The walls and the city, 18: And the construction of its wall, jasper; and the city was gold, like pure crystal.
  - 2C** The foundations, vv.19-20: 19 The foundations of the wall of the city were adorned with every precious stone: the first foundation, jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, chalcedony; the fourth, smaragdus; 20 the fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, Beryl; the ninth, topaz; the tenth, chrysoprase; the eleventh, hyacinth, the twelfth, amethyst.
  - 3C** The gates and the street, 21: And the twelve gates, twelve pearls; above each one of the gates was from a single pearl; and the street of the city pure gold, like a translucent crystal.
- 9B** The temple of the city, 22: And I did not see a temple in it; for the Lord God Almighty is its temple, and the Lamb.
- 10B** The light of the city, vv.23-25:
- 1C** No need for conventional lighting, 23a: And the city did not have need of the sun, nor the moon, that they might shine on it;
  - 2C** The light of the glory, 23b: for the glory of God illuminated it, and its lamp was the Lamb.
  - 3C** The enjoyment and reflection of the glory, 24: And the Gentiles will walk through its light; and the kings of the earth will bring their glory and honor it.
  - 4C** 24/7: 25 And its gates will certainly not be close by day – for there will be no night there –

- 5C The reflection of the glory, 26: and they will bring the glory and honor of the Gentiles to it;
- 6C The respect of the glory, 27: And they will certainly not bring anything common into it, or any cause of abomination and lie; only those who are written in the book of Life of the Lamb.
