

## **Revelation 22 Outline**

- 1A** The continued description of the new Jerusalem, vv.1-5:
  - 1B** The river of life, 1: And he showed me a pure river of the water of Life, radiant as crystal, issuing forth from the throne of God and the Lamb.
  - 2B** The tree of life, 2: In the midst of its street, and on either side of the river, from here and there, the tree of life, bearing twelve fruits, giving forth fruit each month. And the leaves off the tree for a healing of the Gentiles.
  - 3B** The end of every curse, 3: And every curse will be no more; and the throne of God and the Lamb are in it; and the twelve servants will serve Him,
  - 4B** The relationship with the Lamb, 4: And they will see His face; and His name is upon their forehead.
  - 5B** The eternal light, 5: And there will be no night there, and they will not need a lamp and sunlight, because the Lord God will shine on them; and He will reign forever and ever.
- 2A** Testimonies and promises, vv.6-9:
  - 1B** The angel's testimony concerning the description, 6: And he says to me, "These are the words faithful and true;" And God of the spirits of the prophets sent His angel to show His servants what is necessary to happen quickly.
  - 2B** Jesus' promises, 7: "And look, I am coming quickly. Blessed are those who keep the words of the prophecy of this book."
  - 3B** John's testimony, 8a: And I John am the one who heard and saw these things.
  - 4B** His resulting and mistaken worship, 8b: And when I heard and saw, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel who showed me these things.
  - 5B** The angel's prohibition, 9: And he says to me, "See not. I am your fellow-servant, and of your brothers the prophets, and of those who keep the words of this book. Worship God.
- 3A** The angel's prohibition against sealing, 10: And he says to me, "Do not seal the words of the prophecy of this book; for the time is near.
- 4A** The continued status quo, 11: The one who is unjust let him be unjust still; and the one who is filthy, let him be filthy still; and the one who is righteous, let him do righteousness still; the holy one, let him be holy still."
- 5A** Promise of Jesus to come quickly to reward, 12: "And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward with with Me, to reward each one as work will be.
- 6A** Self-identification of Jesus, 13: I am the Alpha and the O, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End."
- 7A** Blessing and exclusions, vv.14-15:
  - 1B** Blessings to the obedient, 14: Blessed are those who do His commandments, that their authority may be over the tree of life, and over those who enter the gates into the city.

- 2B** Exclusion of the disobedient, 15: Outside are the dogs and the poisoners and the immoral and the murderers and the idolaters, and whoever befriends and practices a lie.
- 8A** Self-identification of Jesus, 16: "I, Jesus, sent My angel to testify to you these things to the churches. I Myself am the root and the race of David, the radiant morning star."
- 9A** Invitation from the Spirit and the bride, 17: And the Spirit and the bride say, "Come." And let him who hears say, "Come." And let him who thirsts come; the one who desires let him take freely the water of life.
- 10A** John's final testimony and warning, vv.18-19:
- 1B** Warning against adding, 18: I Myself testify to everyone who hears the word of the prophecy of this book, if anyone adds to these things, God will add upon him the plagues which are written in this book.
- 2B** Warning against subtracting, 19: And if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away from his portion from the tree of life, and from the holy city, and from what is written in this book.
- 11A** Final words of Jesus, 20a: The one who testifies to these things says, "Yes, I am coming quickly."
- 12A** Response of John, 20b: Yes, come quickly Lord Jesus.
- 13A** Conclusion of the letter, 21: The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ with all the saints. Amen.
