

- 5B Reward for faithfulness, 10: Because you kept My word of endurance, then I will keep you from the hour of testing, the one about to come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell upon the earth.
- 6B Exhortation to hold fast, and what is at risk, 11: I am coming quickly, hold fast to what you have, that no one might take your crown.
- 7B Conqueror rewards, 12: The one who conquers, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will certainly not go out any more, and I will write upon him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which descends from heaven from My God, and [has] My new name.
- 8B Call to listen, 13: The one who has an ear let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.
- 3A Letter to the pastor of Laodikeia, vv.14-22:
 - 1B Address, 14a: And to the angel of the church in Laodikeia write,
 - 2B Identity of the speaker, emphasis on incarnation as prototype, 14b: these things say the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God:
 - 3B The failings of the Laodikeians, vv.15-17:
 - 1C Lukewarm, 15: I know your works, that you are neither cold nor boiling; I wished you were cold or boiling.
 - 2C Imminent vomiting, 16: So because you are lukewarm, and not boiling nor cold, I am about to vomit you from My mouth.
 - 3C Independent nature, blind to true needs, 17: Because you say, "I am rich, and I have become wealthy, and I have need of nothing," and you do not know that you are wretched and pitiful and poor and blind and naked,
 - 4B Remedy for failures, 18: I advise you to buy gold from Me, having been refined from fire, that you become rich, and white garments, that you might be clothed, and that the shame of your nakedness might not be revealed; and that He might anoint your eye salve for your eyes, that you might see.
 - 5B General principle regarding training, 19a: As many as I love, I convict and train;
 - 6B Command to repentance, 19b: therefore be zealous and repent.
 - 7B Final appeal, 20: Look, I stand at the door and I knock; if anyone might hear My voice, and open the door, then I will come to him, and I will dine with him, and he with Me.
 - 8B Conqueror reward, 21: The one who conquers I will give to him to sit with Me on My throne, as I also have conquered and sit with My father on His throne.
 - 9B Call to listen, 22: The one who has an ear let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

Revelation Chapter Three Outline

1A Letter to the pastor of Sardis, vv.1-6:

1B Address, 1a: And to the angel of the church in Sardis write,

2B Identity of the speaker, emphasis on His authority over the Holy Spirit and pastors, 1b: these things says the one who has the seven spirits of God and the seven stars;

3B Their failing, 1c: I know your works, that you have a name that you live, and you are dead.

4B Exhortations to remedy the failing, vv.2-3a:

1C Watch and stabilize, with explanation, 2: Become watchful, and stabilize the remaining things, which you are about to cast off; for I have not found your works having become complete before My God.

2C Remember, keep and repent, 3a: Remember therefore how you received and heard, and keep, and repent.

5B Consequences of continuation on current course, 3b: Therefore if you will not watch, I will come upon you as a thief, and you will certainly not know which hour I come upon you.

6B Presence of a few good believers, 4: But you have a few names in Sardis, who have not defiled their garments, and walk with Me in white, because they are worthy.

7B Conqueror rewards, 5: The one who conquers, this one will be clothed in white garments; and I will certainly not erase his name from the book of life, and I will confess him before My Father, and before His angels.

8B Call to listen, 6: The one who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

2A Letter to the pastor of Philadelphia, vv.7-13:

1B Address, 7a: And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write,

2B Identity of the speaker, emphasis on character and power, 7b: "These things says the Holy, the Truth, who has the key of David, who opens and no one shuts, and who certainly does not open and none one will open.

3B Their positive applications, 8: I know your works; look, I have given before you a door which has been opened, which no one is able to shut it, because you have a little power, and you kept My word, and did not deny My name.

4B Jesus' dealing with the false Jews in relation to the Philadelphians, 9: Look, I give over from the synagogue of Satan, those who call themselves to be Jews, and are not, but they lie; look, I make them that they come and show obeisance before you feet, and know that I loved you.
