

- 3B Positive application of the truth, 13: I know your works and where you dwell, where the throne of Satan is; and you hold fast to My name, and you do not deny My faith in the days in which Antipas was my martyr, the faithful one, who was killed beside you, where Satan dwells.
- 4B First failings, anti-semitism and licentiousness, 14: But I have a few things against you, because you have there a holding of the teaching of Balaam, who taught Balak to cast a stumbling block before the sons of Israel, and to eat idol-sacrifices and to fornicate.
- 5B Similarity of the failing to the Nikolaitans, 15: Thus you have also a holding of the teaching like the Nikolaitans.
- 6B Call to repent, 16a: Therefore repent, or else I am coming quickly,
- 7B Consequences of continuation, 16b: and I will make war against you with the sword of My mouth.
- 8B Call to listen, 17a: The one who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.
- 9B Conqueror rewards, 17b: To the one who overcomes I will give to him to eat the manna of the hidden one, and I will give to him a white stone, and upon the stone is written a new name, which no one knows except the one who receives.
- 4A Letter to the pastor of Thuateira, vv.18-29:
 - 1B Address, 18a: And to the angel of the church in Thuateira write:
 - 2B Identity of the speaker, emphasis on omnipresence and purity, 18b: This says the Son of God, the One who has eyes like a flame of fire, and feet like fine brass;
 - 3B Positive applications, 19a: I know your works, and love and faith and service and your endurance, and your works, the last are greater than the first.
 - 4B Failing in the toleration of a false prophet toward licentiousness, 20: But I have against you that you allow that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, and teaches and deceives my servants to fornicate and to eat idol-sacrifices.
 - 5B The Patience of Jesus with Jezebel, 21 And I gave her time that she might repent from her works.
 - 6B The consequences of continuation, and results, 23: And her children I will kill with death, and all the churches will know that I Myself am the One who searches kidneys and hearts; and I will give to each of you according to your works.
 - 7B Message to the pure ones in Thuateira, 24: And I will say to you, and to the rest of those in Thuateira, who do not have this teaching, who do not know the depths of Satan, as they say, I will cast upon you no other weight.
 - 8B Exhortation to the pure ones in Thuateira, 25: Only hold fast to what you have, until when I might come.
 - 9B First conqueror reward, 26: And the one who overcomes and keeps My works until the completion, I will give to him authority over the nations;
 - 10B Explanation of the conqueror reward, 27 And shepherd them with an iron rod; like the vessels of the potter they will be dashed to pieces as I have also received from My Father;
 - 11B Second conqueror reward, 28: And I will give to him the morning star.
 - 12B Call to listen, 29: The one who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

Revelation Chapter Two Outline

1A Letter to the pastor of Ephesus, vv.1-7:

- 1B** Address, 1a: To the angel of the church in Ephesus write,
- 2B** Identity of the speaker, emphasis on authority and vital presence, 1b: “This says the one who holds the seven stars in His right hand, the one who walks in the midst of the seven lampstands of gold.
- 3B** Their positive applications of Scripture, vv.2-3: 2 I know your works, and your labor, and your endurance, and that you are not able to bear evil, and you have tested those who claim to be apostles, and are not, and you found them liars; 3 And you have endurance and bear up because of My name, and you do not grow weary.
- 4B** Their only failing, 4: But I have this against you, that you have left your first love.
- 5B** The remedy for their failing, 5a: Remember therefore from where you have fallen, and repent, and do the first works,
- 6B** The consequence of continuation in failing, 5b: or else I am coming to you swiftly, and I will remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent.
- 7B** Another positive, 6: But this you have, that you hate the works of the Nikolaitans, which I also hate.
- 8B** Call to listen, 7a: The one who has an ear let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.
- 9B** Conqueror reward, 7b: To the one who conquers I will give to him to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of My God.

2A Letter to the pastor of Smyrna, vv.8-11:

- 1B** Address, 8a: And to the angel of the church in Smyrna write,
- 2B** Identity of the speaker, emphasis on creation, summation, and resurrection, 8b: “This says the first and the last, who became dead and lived.
- 3B** Positive applications of Scripture, 9a: I know your works and the tribulation and poverty, but you are rich,
- 4B** Their failing, 9b: and the blasphemy of those who call themselves to be Jews, and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan.
- 5B** Exhortation in anticipation of intense suffering, 10a: Fear nothing of what you are about to suffer.
- 6B** Nature of the coming suffering, 10b: Look, truly the devil is about to cast some of you into prison, that you might be tested; and you will have tribulation for ten days.
- 7B** Reward for endurance through the suffering, 10c: Become faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.
- 8B** Call to listen, 11a: The one who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches,
- 9B** Conqueror reward, 11b: “The one who conquers will certainly not be harmed from the second death.”

3A Letter to the pastor of Pergamos, vv.12-17:

- 1B** Address, 12a: And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write,
- 2B** Identification of the speaker, emphasis on truth, 12b: This says the one who has the sharp two-edged sword;
